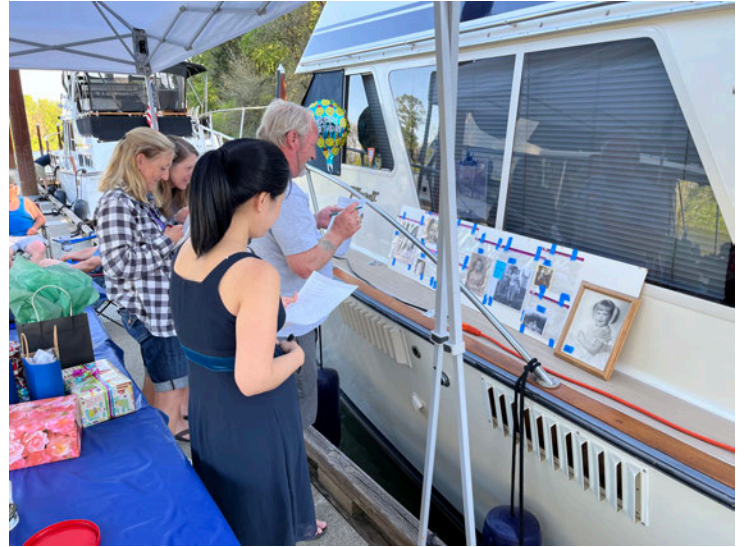
Coon Island East BIRTHDAY/FLAT FISH Cruise - May 12 - 14, 2023
