Meeting was held April 18th, 2023 on Zoom at 7pm.

- Call to order- President Alicia Robinson-DYC
- Roll Call and Minutes - acting Secretary - Ron Bergmann - 14 Participants
- Treasurer report - Doug Vandercoevering - NOTS
  - \$41,596 balance
- Vice Presidents report - Ron Bergmann MCYC
- Guest Speaker: Sgt. Steve Dangler - MCSO
  - Very busy river clean ups around Ross Island / Willamette River. 40 derelict vessels.
  - Oregon HB 2914-2 requires committee to be in place when the ORE. Governor budget containing 18.7 million dollars is available.
  - CRYA, WOOO, MCSO river patrol and Rocky Pointe Marina all testified.
  - METRO also has a temporary program for environmentally responsible way to get rid of a unseaworthy boat. The program will continue until June 30th, 2023 or until funds are exhausted.
  - Multnomah County Sheriff River Patrol staffing staying full. Clark County has the money, but not the staff for full-time on the Columbia, but do for Wash. lakes.
- Opening Day & Other Items Related to Rose Festival Events
  - CRYA will invite Sheriff to attend CRYA Opening Day.
  - The Portland Rose Festival "FLEET WEEK", June 7-12 will have: 3 US Coast Guard, 3 Canadian and 3 US NAVY ships.
